Travel & Lodging Details

Arrival & Departure: Please make your travel arrangements so that you will arrive in Arlington, VA with enough time to attend the entire meeting. The meeting is scheduled to start at **8:00 am** on **Thursday, December 2, 2004** and conclude at **4:00 pm** on **Friday, December 3, 2004**.

Lodging: The meeting will be held at the Doubletree Crystal City in Arlington, VA (just outside of Washington, DC). Please call 1-866-999-VIEW to reserve your room at the Doubletree. Travel to & from the Airport:

The Doubletree Crystal City is located two miles from Reagan National Airport. There is a free shuttle from National Airport to the hotel. Use the phone in the baggage claim area to contact the hotel when you arrive. Washington Dulles International Airport and Baltimore/Washington International Airport are both about 50 miles away. A cab ride from these airports would be over \$60. Trains will arrive at Union Station in Washington, DC. Union Station is about 10 miles from the hotel. A cab ride is about \$15-\$17.
