Target Audience: Attendees should be Weed and Seed teams consisting of a community police officer, a Steering Committee member, the Site Coordinator, and a representative from the United States Attorney's Office. At a minimum, two participants (a community police officer and a Steering Committee member – preferably a resident) must represent sites. Participants must attend with a team of individuals from their community. U.S. Attorney staff are encouraged to attend, but not required. We encourage your Steering Committee to approve participants attending the conference.

Course Description: This two-day course will provide community members, public safety officials, and other governmental organizations an opportunity to work together as teams to identify and work on specific problems in their communities. The course incorporates community-policing principles that help to facilitate change through team building, partnerships, problem solving strategies, and action planning to build local capacity that reduces violence and sustains prevention and neighborhood restoration efforts.
