## ***Purpose and Methodology***

### **Purpose**

This report is the third in a series of reports examining national priority related DHS funded activities. *Emergency Operations Planning: DHS Funded Activities* highlights major state, urban area, regional and local initiatives designed to Strengthen Emergency Operations Planning and Citizen Protection Capabilities which are funded with Department of Homeland Security grant programs including the Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) and the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI).

### ***National Priority***

Strengthen Emergency Operations Planning and Citizen Protection Capabilities

### **Methodology**

The projects described in this report have been reported directly to the Department of Homeland Security Office of Grants and Training by state and local users of the Grants Reporting Tool (GRT) through the submission of their Bi-annual Strategy Implementation Report (BSIR).

The project types listed below in the fiscal years 2004 and 2005 BSIRs from the June 2006 calendar year submission were used to identify projects that Strengthen Emergency Operations Planning and Citizen Protection Capabilities. Previous submissions were used for the District of Columbia (December 2005) and Puerto Rico (June 2005) due to the status of those submissions at the time of this report.


National Emergency Operations Planning Projects Allocation Summary for Fiscal Years 2004 and 2005.
