OJJDP RELEASES 2018 ANNUAL REPORT TO CONGRESS

WASHINGTON – The Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention today released its 2018 Annual Report to Congress. The report describes programs and activities that OJJDP carried out in fiscal year 2018.

OJJDP awarded approximately \$300 million to fund programs, research, training and technical assistance, and information dissemination activities that enhance public safety, ensure young offenders are held appropriately accountable, and empower youth to live productive, law abiding lives.
