## NIJ Advisory Notice #02-2010

SUBJECT: GH Armor Systems Body Armor Model 06UG2A8H

The National Institute of Justice (NIJ) hereby advises that GH Armor Systems Body Armor Model 06UG2A8H has been suspended from the NIJ Compliant Products List. Suspension has occurred because of the noncompliance of a single production sample with our continued compliance monitoring program. Following the completion of an ongoing evaluation, the compliance status of this model will be reassessed.

Law enforcement and corrections officers currently wearing this model of armor are encouraged to continue wearing it or other NIJ Compliant Body Armor until such time as this suspension is resolved.
